Service Club completes Cindy's Angels Service Project

The St. James Service Club's (STJSC) annual project, "Cindy's Angels," named in 2020 in memory of Cindy Kirwan, who chaired the project for several years, returned to St. James for its 28th consecutive year to provide a happier holiday for children and families at Brunswick Family Assistance (BFA), seniors supported by Brunswick Senior Resources Inc. (BSRI), and teenagers and foster children residing at the Boys and Girl Home of Lake Waccamaw (B&GH).

Once again, the St. James Community displayed its support and generosity for this annual service project by making the holidays brighter for 163 individuals: 75 needy children/families at BFA; 57 seniors supported by BSRI; and 31 teens from B&GH.

In total, the St. James community provided 225 gifts (three per child) to BFA; 114 gifts (two per senior) to BSRI; and 31 \$50 Amazon gift cards to B&GH resident teens, as well as another \$225 in extra Amazon gift cards for foster children. Cash donations totaled \$6,123 enabled \$50 Food Lion gift cards to each child and \$45 Food Lion gift cards to each senior.

The St. James Service Club recognizes project leader Jean Castagnola, angel creator/workshop leader Mary Alice Smith, numerous angel-making volunteers, four tree decorator teams, and local neighborhood gift collectors.
